WARRI NORTH LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCIL

Warri North is a Local Government Area of Delta State, Nigeria. Its headquarters is in the town of Koko. It has an area of 1,841 km² and a population of 137,300 at the 2006 census. The postal code of the area is 332.

Koko a cosmopolitan town that houses a sea port. Conspicuous in the town is the ancient house of Nana Olomu of Itsekiri. The LGA is predominantly over %95 riverine and is inhabited by the Itsekiris and the Ijaw People. The major occupations of the people are fishing, carving of canoes, net weaving, hunting, clothes dyeing, trading and farming. It is also the location of a lovely tourist attraction, the floating market at Ogheye and the Nanna museum. The Local government is richly blessed with Crude oil and houses the Nigeria National Petroleum Company, Chevron oil field amongst others.

Warri North has two traditional stool which are the Ancient stool of the OLU OF WARRI and the AGADAGBA BINI PERE OF EGBEMA

Her traditional foods includes owho and starch, Banga soup and starch, gbagbafofo, Obikanbo and many others.

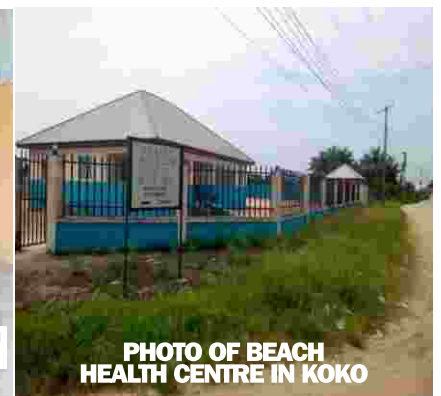

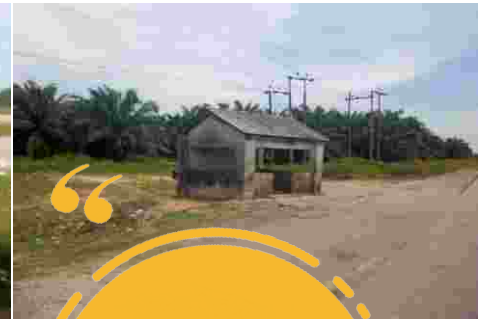

- Effective English -38

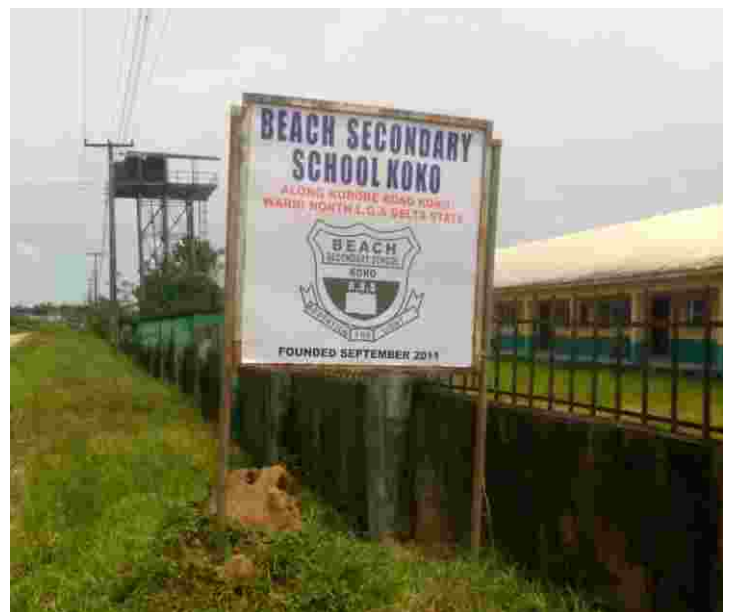
They also got 12 chairs and 7 tables, and 100 chairs from the LGA from 2020 till date (the chairs are nothing to write home about

because the woods are weak)

IWERE College Koko

1. Last year 2022 two teachers represented iwere college Koko in a computer base training in the senatorial area

2. Iwere college got 60 chairs last year 2022, and got 40 chairs in August 2023 from the state government through the local government secretary of education, though the chairs are badly done by the contractor,

3. Just yesterday 30th of October iwere college got some books from the local government secretary of education which includes

- i. Civic education book- 30
- ii. Effective English test book was 38 copies
- iii. Effective mathematics 15 copies
- iv. Social studies - 2

OJOMBA PRIMARY SCHOOL

Ojomba Nursery and primary school didn't get anything yet from the local government, while speaking with the principal most of the intervention have been through NGOs, like Agura iwere, USA Branch, who renovated three blocks of classroom and also made provision of chairs, the federal government also made provision of one building through the ministry of humanitarian affairs (poverty alleviation innovative)

The principal noted that it's not the sore responsibility of the LGA to renovate structure but some can do if they have the passion for education, he also noted that the government have not failed in their duty to pay salary's, he also noted that no training or retraining have been done in the past three years.

UGOGO MEJE PRIMARY SCHOOL

Ugogo meje primary school is before the army check point, outskirts of Koko in the express, the principal said nothing has come from the local government, not even training, but I had an interactive session with one of the teachers who said she was among those trained by the local government last year 2022.



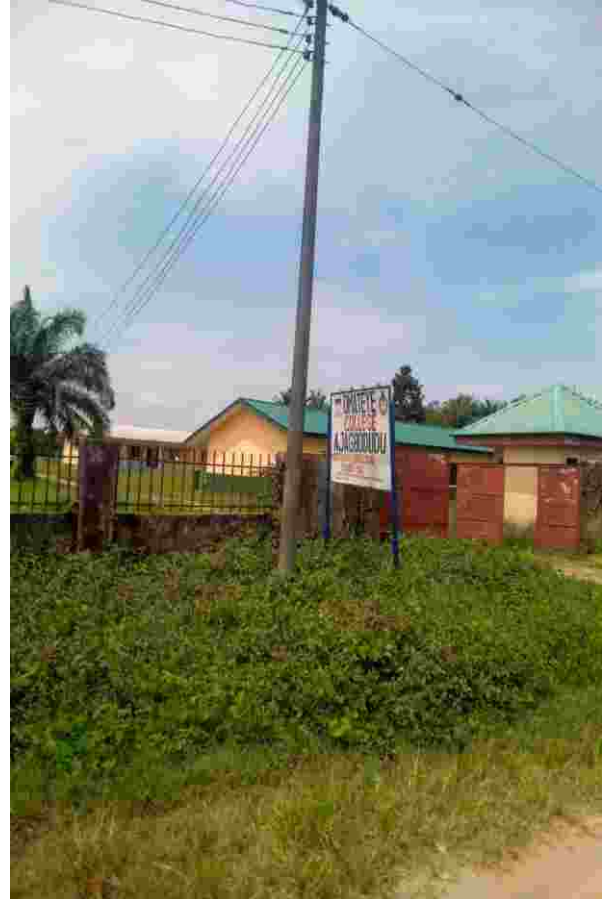

AKUARAJOR PRIMARY SCHOOL KOKO



The Principal of Akuarajor Primary school Koko said that the school has not gotten anything from the Local Government, though they have had individuals and NGOs who have supported them but not from the local government, she noted that they got one block of class room which was poorly constructed, bulk of the students don't have chairs to seat, no light in the school and no water though They got a solar tank / borehole that is not functioning



PROJECTS DISCOVERED

As at the time of giving this report, it was discovered that the Local Government Council chairman did fencing of the local government office, and an extension of the local government was under construction



Okogho community

It was discovered via research that a borehole was sighted at okogho community by the Council, okogho community is a riverine community under abigborodo and not motorable
